Faculty of Pharmacy was established in 2011-2012 academic year and is an English-medium faculty offering M.Pharm. program which takes 5 years composed of 10 semesters as well as Pharm.D. program which takes 6 years composed of 12 semesters.

Our mission as Faculty of Pharmacy of the Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU);

Is to educate pharmacists who embrace the principles of the profession, closely follow global developments in pharmacy, contribute to the protection and improvement of public health, understand the needs of the pharmaceutical industry, and provide qualified contributions to the field; individuals equipped with strong practical skills, high self-confidence, and effective communication abilities.

Our vision is to be a faculty that is empowered through education, enlightened by science, and provides services to society at an international level; that educates innovative and visionary pharmacists who adhere to ethical values and have a universal perspective within a campus environment equipped with modern infrastructure and in line with contemporary needs; that is recognized and respected worldwide for its scientific research, with strong international collaborations; and that is environmentally friendly, modern, and competitive among global universities.

Faculty of Pharmacy is proud of being the first academic member accepted by International Pharmacy Federation (FIP) from Cyprus Island and the second one among the Faculties of Pharmacy throughout Turkey. Our faculty is also represented through EMUPSS (Eastern Mediterranean University Pharmacy Students Society) as a member association of "The International Pharmaceutical Students' Federation" (IPSF) offering Student Exchange Programme. This allows our students the opportunity to conduct clinical and community pharmacy practice in different countries. At the same time, with the same organization our faculty hosts pharmacy students from around the world.

The Faculty has student laboratories equipped with the latest technological and educational infrastructure necessary for pharmaceutical sciences including HPLC, GC-MS, FT-IR, UV spectrophotometer, laminar flow, microwave reactor, tablet machine, dissolution device, granulator, homogenizator, viscosimeter, climate cabinet, incubators, particle sizer, powder mixer, grinder, water baths, microscopes, etc. All of the laboratories are furnished with smart board. The medicinal and aromatic plant garden is arranged in front of the Faculty building for the studies in Pharmaceutical Botany and Pharmacognosy.

Our laboratory facilities are also competent for higher level of research and, despite of its newly establishment, Faculty of Pharmacy has published approximately 500 scientific papers in the reputed journals recognized by Science Citation Index (SCI).

EMU FACULTY OF PHARMACY GRADUATES TOOK THEIR OATHS (29 January 2026)

Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) Faculty of Pharmacy organized an oath taking ceremony for its graduating students on Thursday, 29 January 2026 at 11:00 a.m. at Faculty of Pharmacy Green Hall.

The ceremony commenced with observation of a Moment of Silence and National Anthem, followed by a musical performance by EMU Faculty of Pharmacy student Şahnaz Gökel and musician Yüksel Günay Bilgeer. Present at the ceremony were the EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Hasan Kılıç, EMU Vice Rectors Prof. Dr. Osman M. Karatepe, Prof. Dr. Sonuç Zorlu and Prof. Dr. Ali Öztüren, EMU General Secretary Derviş Ekşici, Dean of the Faculty of Pharmacy Prof. Dr. Hayrettin Ozan Gülcan, Dean of EMU Faculty of Health Sciences Prof. Dr. Mehtap Malkoç, Dean of EMU Dr. Fazıl Küçük Medicine Faculty Prof. Dr. Nilüfer Güzoğlu, the Vice Deans of Faculty of Pharmacy, Department Chairs, academic staff, and graduates.

The program continued with the speeches of 2025 – 2026 Academic Year Fall Semester top ranking student of M.Pharm Yelda Demirkap and top ranking student of Pharm-D program Ailin Kor. Then, the ceremony continued with presentation of awards to Demirkap and Kor by EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Hasan Kılıç and EMU Vice Rector Prof. Dr. Osman M. Karatepe.

“A Comprehensive Academic Journey”

In his opening remarks, Prof. Dr. H. Ozan Gülcan, Dean of EMU Faculty of Pharmacy, highlighted that pharmacy education extends far beyond earning a diploma, representing a comprehensive academic journey marked by dedication, discipline, and perseverance. He noted that graduates who have completed a high-quality theoretical and practical education in line with international standards are prepared as pharmacists who uphold professional ethics, embrace continuous improvement, and demonstrate a strong sense of responsibility. Prof. Dr. Gülcan emphasized that, amid rapidly advancing healthcare systems and technological innovations, graduates are well equipped to contribute to and shape future pharmacy practices. Underscoring the pharmacy profession’s longstanding and vital role in protecting human health, he expressed his belief that graduates will honor their professional oath, provide healing and value to society, and act as committed ambassadors of EMU and its Faculty of Pharmacy on the international stage.

“To Represent the Values and Ethical Integrity of Eastern Mediterranean University”

Also making an address at the event, EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Hasan Kılıç highlighted that graduates of the Faculty of Pharmacy are equipped not only with professional expertise, but

also with strong ethical principles, a deep sense of responsibility, and an understanding of the impact their work has on human lives. Emphasizing the pharmacy profession’s distinctive role in healthcare as a source of trust, hope, and moral responsibility, Prof. Dr. Kılıç pointed out that Alexander Fleming’s decision to share penicillin with humanity underscores the importance of science-led progress and placing people at the heart of all endeavors. He stated that by taking their professional oath, graduates formally embarked on their careers and will henceforth represent the values and ethical integrity of Eastern Mediterranean University in every step they take. Prof. Dr. Kılıç concluded by wishing the graduates a career marked by success, good health, and honor.



“View Medicine as More Than a Product—As Hope and Life”

In a message sent to the graduates, EMU Board of Trustees President Dr. Erdal Özçenk stressed that by taking their professional oath, the graduates are assuming a profound responsibility that directly impacts human lives. He described pharmacy as an honorable profession where knowledge is guided by conscience and science is united with respect for human dignity, emphasizing that medicines should be seen not merely as commercial products, but as symbols of hope and life. Dr. Özçenk reminded the graduates never to compromise scientific principles or professional ethics, and expressed his complete confidence in them, stating his belief that wherever their careers may take them, they will proudly carry the name and values of Eastern Mediterranean University.



The ceremony continued with EMU Vice Rectors Prof. Dr. Sonuç Zorlu and Prof. Dr. Ali Öztüren, and EMU General Secretary Derviş Ekşici presenting certificates to students and their advisors who achieved distinction in the Fall Semester Graduation Poster Presentations. Following the presentation of certificates, the program continued with a special photo slideshow showcasing memorable moments from the graduates' academic journey. The ceremony concluded as EMU Faculty of Pharmacy Vice Dean Assist. Prof. Dr. Jale Yüzügülen led the graduates in the recitation of the Pharmacy Oath.

The “Student Workshop 2026,” organized by the Faculty of Pharmacy at Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU), was held in the EMU Faculty of Pharmacy meeting hall. The workshop, organized in collaboration with the Cyprus Turkish Pharmacists Association and the EMU Strategy and Project Development Office, was coordinated and moderated by Dr. Jülide Erdal Üngör. In addition to EMU Faculty of Pharmacy faculty members and students, participants also included representatives from the Cyprus Turkish Pharmacists Association management and community and hospital pharmacists.

The workshop aimed to create a strong communication and collaboration environment between academic education and professional practice. It also sought to improve the internship processes for students at the EMU Faculty of Pharmacy and to identify solutions to the problems encountered during these processes.

Prof. Dr. H. Ozan Gülcan, Dean of the Faculty of Pharmacy at Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU), in his speech at the event, thanked all participants, especially the President of the Cyprus Turkish Pharmacists Association, Pharmacist Duygu Adahan Kuran, and emphasized the great importance of the opinions of internal and external stakeholders in the creation of the student workshop. In an event organized with the contributions of the Dean's Office of the Faculty of Pharmacy and the TEBGK (Turkish Pharmacists Association Youth Commission) student representatives, Mr. Sinan Özçelik, a pharmacist working in a community pharmacy in Antalya and a former chamber president, gave a talk on "Pharmacists and Community Pharmacy" on Friday, March 27, 2026, at 2:00 PM in the Green Hall of the Faculty of Pharmacy.

PRECEPTOR TRAINING SEMINAR (4 APRIL 2026)



The event, held on April 4, 2026, at the Faculty of Pharmacy of Eastern Mediterranean University, in collaboration with the Cyprus Turkish Pharmacists Association, was attended by numerous faculty members, academics, community and hospital pharmacy pharmacists, and student representatives. The event, which began with a moment of silence and the singing of the national anthem, first featured a speech by the President of the Cyprus Turkish Pharmacists Association (CTPA), Pharmacist Duygu Karahan Kuran. In her speech, Karahan expressed her satisfaction with the organization of such an event and conveyed her thanks to the Faculty of Pharmacy of Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU). Reminding that training programs are lifelong processes and important for professional development and continuity, the CTPA president stated that the continuity of these activities is a necessity.

Speaking next, Prof. Dr. H. Prof. Dr. Bilge Sözen Şahne, a faculty member of Hacettepe University Faculty of Pharmacy, who conducted the training.

During the training, Assoc. Prof. Dr. Şahne shared information with the participants on professional role modeling, expectation management, patient safety, communication/teamwork, and leadership. Elements that would assist pharmacists and students in their collaborative work, from the perspectives of scientific, health, patient, and social relations, were discussed, starting from the time pharmacy students begin their internships in community pharmacies.

The event highlighted the increasing importance of professional seminars in light of rapidly changing technology and new applications, and stated that internship activities, which play a significant role in training future pharmacists, will be carried out more effectively through collaboration between pharmacists working in academia and in the field.



Following the training, Prof. Gülcan presented a plaque to Assoc. Prof. Dr. Bilge Sözen Şahne, who conducted the training. Additionally, the Dean of the Faculty of Pharmacy at EMU and the President of CTPA presented participation certificates to all attendees.
